MATT MEAD SERVED AS WYOMING'S 32ND GOVERNOR from 2011 to 2019. During his time as Governor, he focused on economic development, energy solutions, and building and strengthening infrastructure across the State. He worked on species conservation, homelessness, health care and education. He took great pride in supporting the military, our veterans and viewed his role as the Commander in Chief of the Wyoming National Guard as a great privilege.

While Governor, he took on national leadership roles serving as Vice Chairman and Chairman of the National Governors Association Natural Resources Committee. He was elected by



fellow governors to regional leadership serving as Vice Chairman and Chairman of the Western Governors' Association.

Matt graduated from the University of Wyoming College of Law in 1987. Prior to becoming Governor, he opened a private law practice, served as an assistant county prosecutor and as an Assistant United States Attorney. He was appointed United States Attorney for the District of Wyoming by President George W. Bush in 2001 and served in that capacity until 2007.

Matt, born and raised in Jackson, Wyoming. He and his wife of 28 years, Carol, now live in southern Wyoming with their two children. They
